Who can go? Any youth, from any county in California, **between the ages of 8 and 19** as of June 27, 2010 is eligible to attend 4-H Summer Camp
Campers will need to enroll in 4-H to attend

Where is 4-H camp? Camp Seeley is owned by the City of Los Angeles and is located in the San Bernardino Mountains, above the town of San Bernardino and is nestled in a forest of tall pines at an elevation of 4,200 feet. Close to Lake Gregory and the Village of Crestline, it is located on Highway 138, four miles from Lake Silverwood.

What do we do during the week? Camp is one of the quickest and most rewarding weeks of the year for campers. We have daily activities which will include a science element for 3 days of the camp, learning to use a compass and map and fun evening events every night. Also, each day is our own sort of 'holiday', and we celebrate by dressing up and decorating the camp to show our team spirit. There is a huge variety of activities for campers to enjoy—there's something for everybody here! Campers get the choice with certain activities to choose what they want to do, and learn many new things. Some activities include: hikes, camp songs, swimming, crafts, sports, Talent Night, and drive-in movie night.

And the food? Forget what you've heard about Summer Camp food. The meals at 4-H Camp are prepared fresh for each mealtime and include a delectable nutritional balance of food that even picky eaters will enjoy! Since the food is prepared onsite, the cooks are always very accommodating to dietary restrictions and food allergies. A Nurse is available full time during camp. NOTE: Cell phones do not work and there is no internet or TV at Camp !

Cost for the week: Only \$275.00 !

Full or partial camperships may be available for those who need financial assistance to attend. There is no charge to parents who volunteer to serve as chaperones, although they must also enroll as a 4-H leader prior to attending Camp. 4-H Camp is limited to the first 200 youth who reserve a spot and camp sold out last year, so send in the \$50 deposit today ! LA County 4-H Summer Camp is accredited by the American Camping Association (ACA) and youth from Operation Military Kids (OMK) will also be in attendance. If you are 14 years or older, the deadline to apply to be on Camp Staff is March 31st.
